


## Globes and Hemispheres

As you know, Earth is a large, round planet. To see all of Earth, you would have to orbit it in a space! An easier way to see Earth is to look at a small model called a globe.

**A** globe shows Earth's four oceans and seven continents. A globe also shows how Earth turns on an imaginary center line called an axis. At the ends of this line are the North and South poles. Pole means "end." These poles help you find directions on Earth. North is toward the North Pole, and south is toward the South Pole.



**A** polar imaginary line on a globe is called the equator. The equator runs around the center of Earth and divides it into two halves called hemispheres. The northern half is called the Northern Hemisphere, and the southern half is called the Southern Hemisphere.




This chart below shows degrees of latitude and longitude of some major cities. Find the coordinates on the map above and write the names of the cities to complete the chart.
